## Port Deposit Announces Two Property Improvement Programs

This program also provides up to \$10,000 per property to assist with the repair or replacement of sidewalks, retaining walls, landscaping, driveways, and stormwater management improvements.

Eligible property owners may apply for both grant programs. Together, these funding opportunities aim to enhance the historic integrity, visual appeal, and overall marketability of residential and commercial properties throughout the Port Deposit Historic District.
