## TOWN OF PORT DEPOSIT PRESS RELEASE

### TOWN OF PORT DEPOSIT CANDIDATE VERIFICATION AND CANCELLATION OF THE 2025 ELECTION

On March 12, 2025, the Board of Supervisors of Elections for Town of Port Deposit verified that the following individuals filed a Petition for Elected Office and a Financial Disclosure Statement for two (2) of the four (4) seats on the Port Deposit Council, which will expire in May 2025. The candidates for the two Council seats are Incumbent Daniel Berlin and Thomas Knight. The Board certified that the two candidates have met the requirements for the elected office and are unopposed for the two (2) Council seats up for election in May 2025. Pursuant to Section 610, d. of the Port Deposit Charter, the Board of Supervisors of Elections cancelled the May 13, 2025 municipal election having certified the candidates as duly elected and unopposed for two (2) of the four (4) Council seats. At the Council meeting on June 3, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. in Town Hall, 64 S. Main Street, Port Deposit, Candidates Daniel Berlin and Thomas Knight will take the Oath of Office for a four-year term to expire in May 2029 as per Section 609 of the Port Deposit Charter. The public is invited to attend.
