**MARYLAND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM  
MINORITY BUSINESS PLAN**

***A Resolution by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Port Deposit to adopt a Minority Business Plan as required by the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for Community Development Block Grant funds.***

**WHEREAS**, State of Maryland through the Department of Housing and Community Development has solicited applications from eligible jurisdictions to apply for funding under the Maryland Community Development Block Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Port Deposit is eligible to apply for funds from the Maryland Community Development Block Grant program through the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Port Deposit intend to comply with the Minority Business Plan requirement to apply for Community Development Block Grant program funding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council of the Town of Port Deposit hereby adopt and shall maintain a written *Minority Business Plan*. The plan shall be effective for a 3-year period until July 20, 2024, and is attached to this Resolution.
