

Town of Port Deposit Town Council Meeting Minutes Work Session Meeting Conference/Video Meeting July 21, 2020

The public was invited to call into the meeting via videoconferencing or audio by phone.

CALL TO ORDER

Update from Bainbridge Development Corporation — Carl Roberts, Steve Cassard, and Toni Sprenkle. Members of the BDC (Bainbridge Development Corporation) provided the Council with various updates since the last update provided last September. Some of the information provided included the hope to break ground in August or September pending formal approvals from the county, relocation of the Cecil College Driver Training office and classrooms, recent fires at the Tome School and updated security measures on the Bainbridge property. Toni Sprenkle discussed Chief of Police Smith, the Cecil County Sheriff's Office, and the States Attorney's Office contribution to helping with trespassers caught on Bainbridge.

OLD BUSINESS – Finance Manager Sookiasian presented the new lawn mower considered for purchase for the Public Works Department.

Motion was made by Deputy Mayor Kuhs to approve the purchase of the new lawn mower. Seconded by Councilman Knight. All in favor. Motion carried.
