#### Marina Park Revitalization Underway with \$750,000 TAP Grant

Big things are happening at Marina Park! The Town of Port Deposit is proud to announce progress on a \$750,000 Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Grant that is funding the creation of engineering plans for the long-term revitalization.

KCI Technologies Inc. is leading the engineering and design work, with Wood Valley Community Strategies serving as project manager. The planning effort includes revitalization of the retaining wall, upgrades to the fishing pier and boat launch, and improved vehicle circulation throughout the park. With these "shovel-ready" engineering plans in hand, the Town will be well-positioned to pursue additional funding and into phased construction to complete the improvements. "Marina Park has long been a centerpiece of Port Deposit's connection to the Susquehanna River, and this TAP Grant represents a major milestone for our community," said Mayor Tome, Jr. "These plans will help us restore and enhance the park, while positioning the Town to move forward with improvements that will be enjoyed for generations to come."
