



**Town of Port Deposit
Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes
February 1, 2022**

CALL TO ORDER – Chairman Brown called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

PRESENT – In person: Mayor Kuhs, Councilman Knight, Town Administrator Rinkerman, Chief of Police Smith, and Sgt. Morgan, Perryville Police Department. Via Zoom: Chairman Brown

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – The minutes from the January 4, 2022 Public Safety Meeting were presented.

Motion made by Mayor Kuhs to approve the January 4, 2022 minutes. Seconded by Councilman Knight. All in favor. Motion carried unanimously.

COMPUTER DEMONSTRATION

Sergeant Morgan of the Perryville Police Department provided a demonstration of the RMS computer system as requested by Chief Smith and the Public Safety Committee. RMS is a County system which all of the local Cecil County police departments use. He explained that the Maryland State Police, Maryland Department of Transportation Authority, and other state agencies use a different program called Kaplan. Sergeant Morgan provided a detailed overview and demonstration of the different functions and capabilities of other programs including NCIC and the issuance of violations through the Etix program. Discussion ensued regarding the air card and usage of the computer hardware from the patrol car to the office. Sergeant Morgan explained that the CAD program provides detailed history of work completed by the Officer if requested.
