



**Town of Port Deposit
Town Council Meeting Minutes
Work Session Meeting
Conference/Video Meeting
September 20, 2022**

The public was invited to call into the meeting via videoconferencing or audio by phone.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Kuhs called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

PRESENT: In person: Mayor Kuhs, Deputy Mayor Brown, Councilman Knight, Councilman Tome Jr., and Town Administrator Rinkerman. Via Zoom: Councilman Berlin and Treasurer Sookiasian.

PUBLIC COMMENT – Erica Berge, Community Connecting Us President expressed her gratitude for the town’s help and support with the Port Deposit Pirate Takeover event.

OLD BUSINESS

PNC Representative for signatures – Amy Cavanaugh, Assistant Vice President of PNC Bank provided the Council members a signature card and asked them to sign their name and present their ID in order for them to be authorized to sign checks for the town.

Motion was made by Councilman Knight for all Council members to be authorized to sign checks for the town. Seconded by Deputy Mayor Brown. Roll call vote: Tome, Jr. – Y, Berlin – Y, Brown – Y, Knight – Y. Motion carried unanimously.

ARPA – Treasurer Sookiasian provided the Council a list of ARPA projects and asked them to review the list and be prepared to discuss and prioritize the projects listed.

Speed Radar – Treasurer Sookiasian presented information regarding the speed radar units as requested.

Motion made by Councilman Knight to approve the funding for the 2(two) permanent speed radar signs as presented by Treasurer Sookiasian, and to additionally include the mounting hardware and installation costs, using ARPA funds. Seconded by Deputy Mayor Brown. Roll call vote: Tome, Jr. – Y, Berlin – Y, Brown – Y, Knight – Y. Motion carried unanimously.

Fold Down Bollards – Town Administrator Rinkerman presented the fold down bollards suggested for Netter’s Alley. The bollards will come with keys that can be provided to the fire department in case of an emergency, that allows the bollards to fold down. Council directed staff to proceed with ordering and installing the bollards in Netter’s Alley.

Morrison Custom Concrete - POSTPONED


COUNCIL REPORTS – No Council reports.
