



**TOWN OF PORT DEPOSIT
RESOLUTION 12-2023
HOPKINS QUARRY
MASTER RECREATIONAL PARK PLAN**

A Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the Town of Port Deposit, Cecil County, Maryland to adopt the Hopkins Quarry Master Recreational Plan.

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 501, (40) states that the Council shall have the power to establish and maintain public gardens, playgrounds, and other recreational facilities and programs to promote the health, welfare and enjoyment of the inhabitants of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the elected officials recognize the importance of providing quality recreational spaces for the health and well-being of its residents and the surrounding community; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Port Deposit purchased the 67-acre (+/-) property located on the north end of town with Program Open Space funds from the Department of Natural Resources; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive planning process and community input was provided through public meetings, survey, and other engagement methods to ensure the Hopkins Quarry Master Recreational Park Plan reflects the desires and preferences of the residents, and addresses the recreational needs of the entire community; and

WHEREAS, the elected officials have reviewed the draft Hopkins Quarry Master Recreational Park Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Port Deposit that:


- The Mayor and Council hereby adopts the Hopkins Quarry Master Recreational Park Plan as the official guiding document for the development and management of the new park; and
- The Mayor and Council commits to seeking funding and allocating resources for the implementation of the recreational park plan, and
- The Mayor and Council express gratitude to all residents of the town and surrounding community, community organizations, Lardner/Klein Landscape Architects and other professionals who contributed to the development of this park master plan.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED, the Mayor of the Town of Port Deposit is qualified and authorized to execute and deliver documents on behalf of the Town of Port Deposit.


